## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NIME MILE COMMUNITY CUNTER.

We, the undersigned, for the purpose of incorporating the Nine Mile Community Senter, a non-profit association of the State of Montana, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

La

The name of this Association shall be: "NIME MILE COMMUNITY CENTER."

II.

This Association is organized as a non-profit organization for the purpose of providing social, religious, literary and educational advantages for the residents of the Nine Mile area in Missoula County, Montana. To that end, the Association shall have the power to provide and furnish a community center at which meetings of religious, educational, literary, charitable and social groups may be held. The Association shall have power to raise and dishurse funds for general educational and charitable purposes, and shall have power to do any and all acts and things necessary or incidental to the general powers herein expressed, and shall have the power to acquire real and personal property of all kinds, to hold the same and to dispose thereof. The Association shall not be conducted for profit and no profits shall ever be distributed to the members or directors in any manner.

III.

The complete mailing address where the principal

office for the transaction of business of the corporation is to be located is: Nine Mile Community Center, Stark, Missoula County, Montana.

IV,

The directors of the Association shall be three in number, and the names and addresses of those who are to act in the capacity of directors until the election of their successors are:

V.

There shall be but one class of members. Only those persons who are bona fide residents of the Nine Mile Valley in Missoula County, Montana, from the head of said valley to No. 10 Highway shall be eligible for membership. The Association shall, by its by-laws, provide additional qualification for membership and the voting rights thereof.

VI.

At the first meeting of the Association three directors shall be chosen; one to serve three years, one to serve two years, and one to serve one year. Thereafter at each annual meeting one director shall be elected to serve for a three-year term. The by-laws of the Association shall provide for the other officers of the Association, their tenure, duties, method of election, and the manner in which vacancies in office shall be filled.
