ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES, and DUTIES OF AN NMCC BOARD MEMBER

The main role of the NMCC Board is the maintenance and upkeep of the Community Center. The board of directors are responsible for all activities at the Community Center and maintaining revenue programs to support the Community Center.

Board meetings are the second Wednesday of each month (excluding January) at the Community Center. Meetings start at 7 pm and usually last about 90 minutes and attendance is required. Additional commitments include service days that included a spring clean up, annual Craft Fair, and other projects that are required to maintain the buildings and grounds.

Sandstone: \$25

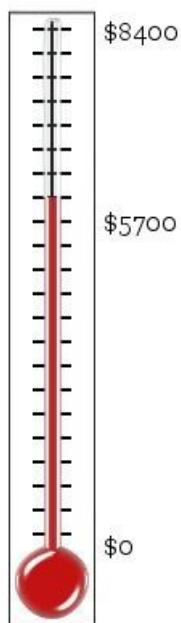
