Stark School Classroom Remodel Completed

The Stark School has seen a lot of mileage since the original construction in 1915. Our recent work in the Classroom focused on restoring its historic aesthetic and upgrading its electrical system. The primary goal was to bring the Classroom back to its original schoolhouse charm.

To facilitate these changes, we removed the wood paneling, crumbling plaster, ceiling tiles, old electrical panel, and neon lights. We then installed new insulation, sheetrock, and painted the walls and ceiling to match the dining room's color, including the window trim, baseboards, passageway, and closet doors. We made significant improvements to energy efficiency for both heating and lighting. This included installing dimmable LED Schoolhouse Pendant lighting fixtures and adding insulation according to our Missoula Electric Coop energy audit. The electrical upgrades also brought in new capacity, ceiling fans, and outlets.

What else was done? How much did it cost? What's next and how can you help with future historic restoration projects? - For these answers and more, talk to a Board member!

We extend a special thank you to local residents Scott Hale for his lighting advice and Brian Palmer for the electrical upgrades, and Fresh Coat Painting for their excellent demolition, sheetrock, and painting work. (Highly Recommended) This project wouldn't have been possible without the generous financial support of many donors.
